**Key Responsibilities & Duties:**

**Education Programs**

Develop proposals, manage budgets and reports for community education programs including but not limited to, Post-Secondary Education, Special Education, Parental and Community Engagement, Teacher Recruitment and Retention and New Paths for Education. Establish long term objectives linked to other community activities and design programs to support those objectives.

**Elementary/Secondary Education**

Reports on success and needed programs and/or services amendments. Encourage staff to be role models for the community and school at all times. Assists the Board in education policy development. Helps in developing operational policies as needed for effective administration. Develops meaningful roles for parents and community in the education system.

**Education Liaison**

Acts as an Education Liaison to his or her respective community, maintaining a network of education contacts in other governments, academic files and private business. Attend selected professional conferences, meetings and workshops to keep abreast of changes in education administration. Participate in the development of cultural and Innu-Aimun resources, materials, and curriculum. Other duties as required.

- Ability to communicate in English and Innu Aïmun is an asset.
